IQHA 2012 Futurity Extravaganza Drug Testing Policy

AQHA drug testing guidelines will be followed with the following exception: No medication report is required to be filed with show management unless you are chosen for drug testing. At that time, you are required to sign a medication report listing the therapeutic medications which are allowed by AQHA that are in the horse's system and agree that the results from the Iowa State University Racing Chemistry Laboratory will be considered final and absolute. If you do not report any of the therapeutic medications and some are found in the test it will be considered a positive test. If the amount of drug in the horse's system is over the allowable limit the test will be considered positive. If any drug other than these conditionally permitted therapeutic medications is found in the horse's system the test will be considered positive. Any horse failing to pass the drug test will forfeit all prize money and awards and charged a fine of \$100 plus lab and vet fees. The fine is to be assessed to the exhibitor and owner. If the fine and fees are not paid, their memberships will be suspended until the account is paid in full. Horses placing below a disqualified horse will be moved up one placing. Any horse failing to pass a drug test in any division of the 2012 Futurity will also be disqualified in the other divisions exhibited, whether or not it was tested in each division.
