

# **Iowa Quarter Horse Breeders Futurity Incentive Program**

#### **PURPOSE**

IQHA Breeders Futurity Incentive Program is designed for breeders, owners, non-pro exhibitors, and trainers to showcase offspring of eligible sires from the IQHA Breeders Futurity. IQHA Breeders Futurity Incentive Program classes will be held during the Iowa Quarter Horse Fall Classic Show and Futurity. Both halter and performance divisions of the program are available.

## **ELIGIBILITY**

- A nominated horse must be sired by a stallion whose breeding(s) sold on the IQHA Breeders Futurity the year the dam of foal was bred.
- Nominators must specify whether the horse is being nominated for the Halter Division or the Performance Division.
- This nomination fee is a one-time payment. IQHA Breeders Futurity Incentive Program offers multiple horse discounts for enrollments.
- AQHA, APHA, or ApHC registered horses may be nominated.

#### HALTER DIVISION

- Eligible weanlings must be nominated by June 1 of their weanling year.
  - Multiple discounts available:
    - 1-3 weanlings \$50.00/horse
    - 4 + weanlings \$40.00/horse
- Nominations must be postmarked on or before July 1 of the weanling year.
  - This nomination fee makes this foal eligible to show in future Breeders Futurity Incentive Program Halter classes.
  - Eligible horses that were not nominated as weanlings may be enrolled as yearlings by April 1 of their yearling year: Yearling fee - \$150.00
- Nominator must be a current IQHA member.

#### Purse Payback

- Purse breakdown for each foal crop year (minus 10% for expenses) is as follows:
  - Weanlings 65% (To be distributed evenly among non pro and open classes)
  - Yearlings 35% (To be distributed evenly among non pro and open classes)
- The foal nominator will receive 10% of the payback, and the horse owner will receive 90% of the payback.
  - In the event that horse ownership changes, the original nominator will receive the 10% earnings.

#### **Classes Offered and Fees**

- The following classes are offered in the Halter Division:
  - Non Pro Weanling Fillies
  - Non Pro Weanling Colts (stallions and geldings)
  - Open Weanling Fillies
  - Open Weanling Colts (stallions and geldings)

- Weanling Fillies and Colts (stallions and geldings) will be split into Early and Late Divisions.
- Non Pro Yearling Fillies
- Non Pro Yearling Stallions
- Non Pro Yearling Geldings
- Yearling Fillies
- Yearling Stallions
- Yearling Geldings
- All entries paid will be jackpotted towards the corresponding class purse. Entry fees
  must be paid at the show by 4:00 P.M. the day before the class shows.
- Entry fees are as follows:
  - Non Pro classes \$125.00 plus a \$20 office charge
  - o Open classes \$175.00 plus a \$20 office charge

#### PERFORMANCE DIVISION

- Eligible yearlings are to be nominated by April 1 of their yearling year with multiple discounts available:
  - o 1-3 yearlings \$100.00/horse
  - 4 + yearlings \$75.00/horse
  - The nomination fee makes horses eligible to show in future Breeders Futurity Incentive Program Performance classes.
- Eligible horses not nominated as yearlings may be enrolled as two year olds by April 1 of their two year old year by paying a \$300 nomination fee.
- Nominator must be a current IQHA member.

## **Purse Payback**

- The yearling nominator will receive 10% of the payback, and the horse owner will receive 90% of the payback.
  - In the event that horse ownership changes, the original nominator will receive the 10% earnings.
- Purse breakdown for each foal crop year (minus 10% for expenses) is as follows:
  - Yearling Longe Line 15%
  - Two Year Old Western Pleasure 35%
  - Three Year Old Western Pleasure 40%
  - Three Year Old Hunter Under Saddle 10%

#### **Classes Offered and Fees**

- The following classes are offered in the Performance Division:
  - Non Pro Yearling Longe Line
  - Open Yearling Longe Line
  - Non Pro Two Year Old Western Pleasure
  - Open Two Year Old Western Pleasure
  - Non Pro Three Year Old Western Pleasure
  - Open Three Year Old Western Pleasure
  - o Non Pro Three Year Old Hunter Under Saddle
  - o Open Three Year Old Hunter Under Saddle
- All entries paid will be jackpotted towards the corresponding class purse.
- Entry fees are to be paid at the show by 4:00 P.M. the day before the class shows.

- o Non Pro \$150.00 plus \$20 office charge
- o Open \$200.00 plus \$20 office charge

## 2019 Inaugural Year

- To get the IQHA Breeders Futurity Incentive Program started in 2019, horses will be grandfathered in if the sire's fee sold in the auction between 2015 & 2-19, inclusive.
- o Nomination deadline is July 1, 2019.
- Weanlings and yearlings eligible for the Halter Division, as well as, two year olds and three year olds eligible for the Performance Division may be enrolled into the program by paying the following fees:
  - Halter Division
    - Weanlings \$50.00
    - Yearlings \$35.00
  - o Performance Division
    - Yearling \$100.00
    - Two Year Old \$85.00
    - Three Year Old \$55.00

### Payout scale

10 places	20%, 15%, 13%, 11%, 10%, 8%, 6.5%, 6%, 5.5%, and 5%
9 Places	21%, 16%, 14%, 12%, 10.5%, 8.5%, 6.5%, 6% and 5.5%
8 places	22%, 16.5%, 15%, 12.5%, 11%, 9%, 7.5% and 6.5%
7 Places	23%, 17%, 15.5%, 13.5%, 12.5%, 10% and 8.5%
6 places	24%, 18%, 17%, 15%, 14% and 12%
5 places	25%, 21%, 20%, 17.5% and 16.5%
4 places	30%, 25.5%, 23% and 21.5%
3 Places	40%, 35% and 25%
2 Places	60% and 40%
1 Place	100%

In case of a point tie for placing, a tiebreaker judge will be used to determine the final standing, but the money will be added together and split equally.
