Class Charges

- All divisions per individual class
\$15/judge
- All Day Fee per horse per division
\$50/judge
- All Day Crossover Fee to one division
\$10/judge
 - All Day Office Charge per day per Horse for one Division and Crossover Fee to another division does not include cattle charges.

1-time admission fee:	\$1/horse/circuit
Computer Fee:	\$6/horse/circuit
Shavings on site:	2 bags required per stall
AQHA fees:	\$6/horse/judge

Steer classes:	Fair market
Calf classes:	Fair market
Wkg Cow classes:	Fair market
Wkg Cow boxing:	Fair market

Roping Jackpot Fee:

- Entry Fee: \$10 charge only in open and amateur with payoff on time.
- Non-participation must be declared at time of entry.
- Late entries to class not included in jackpot

Jumpout Fee:

- \$10/horse/day
- Maximum of \$25/horse/circuit
