

Iowa Quarter Horse Team Challenge

Minimum Requirements

- **4 members**
 - 1 open, 1 amateur/novice amateur, 1 youth
 - 1 English/Western riding horse, 1 Ranch/Reiner riding horse, 1 Futurity halter/lung line/in hand trail ranch horse
- The fourth class and fourth rider are determined by the team.
- Example: 1 Open Hunter Under Saddle rider, 1 Novice Amateur Horsemanship, 1 Youth Ranch Trail rider, 1 Ranch In Hand Trail (This can be any rider any class.)
 - One rider/exhibitor for one class – no rider/exhibitor can show in two classes for the team challenge.
- Team must be decided prior to the first team member's class.
 - Example: Day one of the show but the first team member does not start showing until day 2 at noon, the team must be entered with the show office by day 2 before noon.
 - Team must identify which class for which rider/exhibitor they are going to enter their team with the office.
 - Show office will be responsible for administering checks as well as determining the winning team.
 - The winning team will be determined by the cumulated points under the first set of judges. Any futurity classes will follow the AQHA points chart for the class.
 - When the show is a multi-judge event. The rider's/exhibitor top placing regardless of the judge for that class will be used to determine the points.
 - Example: Rider earned 3, 4 and 1 points under a three judged class. The second judge that awarded 4 points for the rider will be used towards the team's total since it was the highest placing for them for that class.
 - In the event of a tie, the last rider, last class finish will break the tie and then work backwards until the tie is broken.
 - Example: Team 1 and Team 2 each have a total of 20 points for the show. Rider # 4 for team one earned 3 points for their class. Rider # 4 for team 2 earned 2 points for their class. Therefore team 1 is the winner.
 - All other AQHA/IQHA rules apply.
 - Riders may be on as multiple teams. But riders cannot duplicate the exact same team members.
 - Example, Kim, Monte, Nicole and Craig are on a team called "Rodeo Kings/Queens". Exact same team members are on another team named "Superstars"
 - Kim, Monte, Nicole and Kresney are on a team. This is acceptable because one of the team members was changed as long as all other minimum requirements are met.
