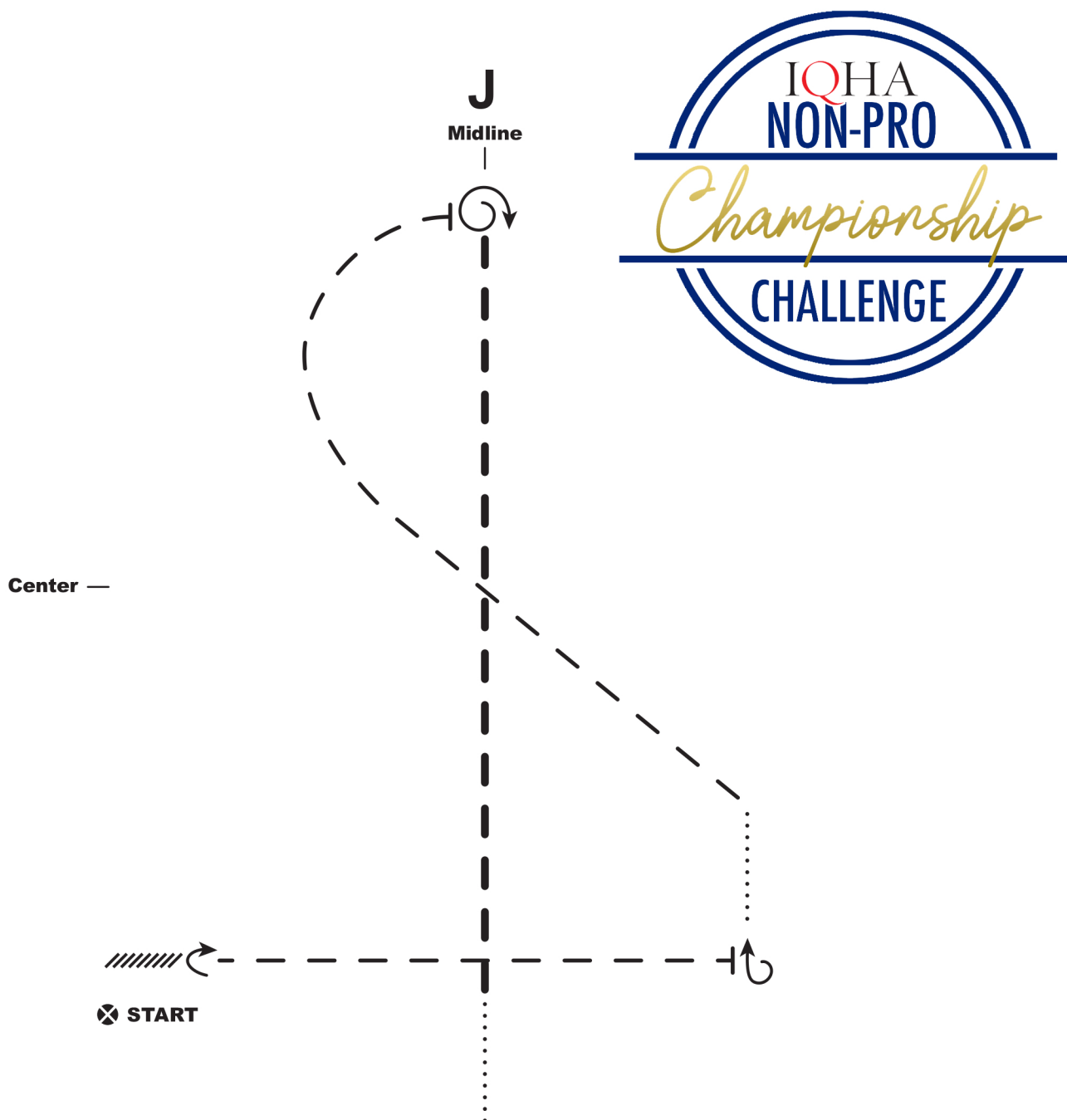


SHOWMANSHIP

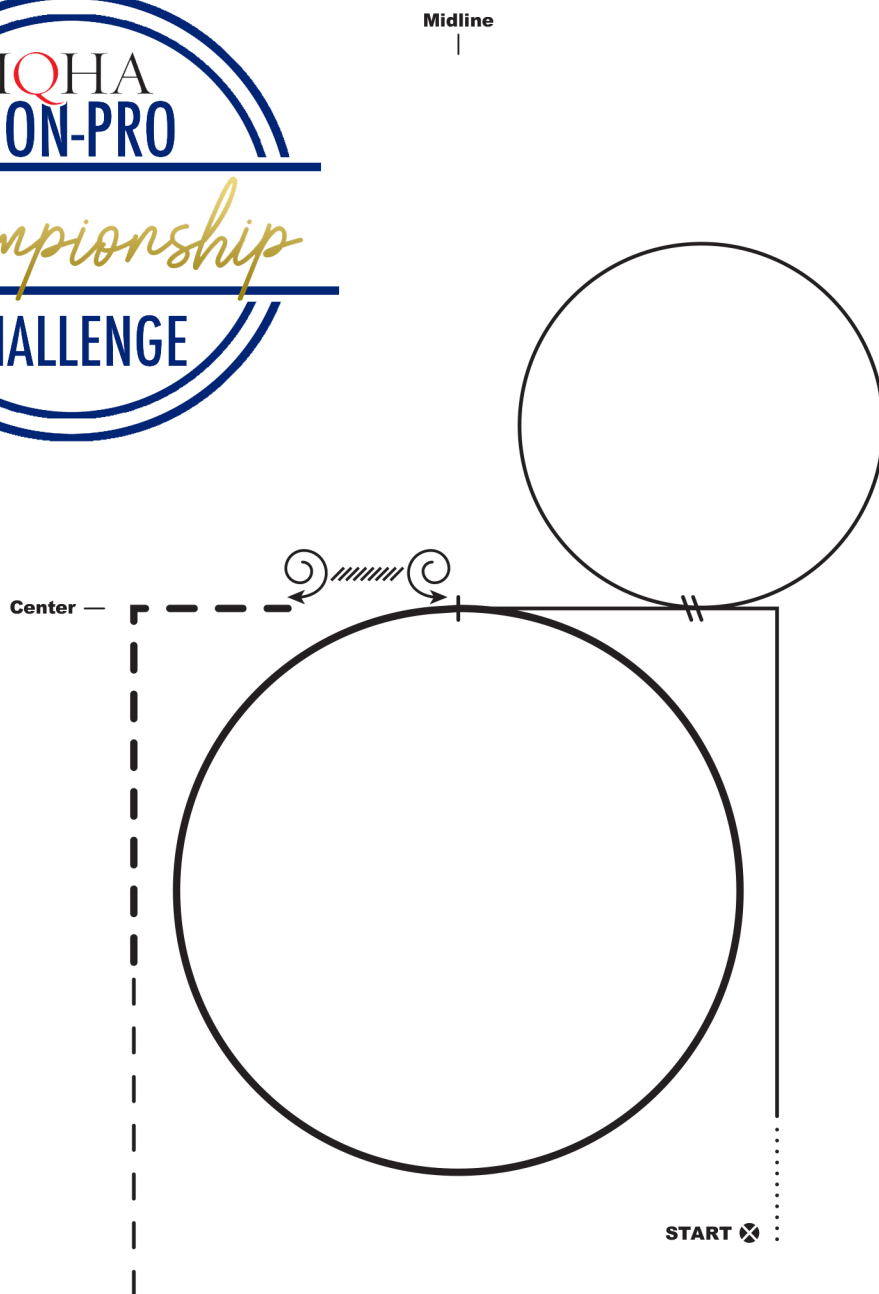


Begin with marker on horse's left.

1. Back approximately 6 steps, and perform a 180° ($1/2$) turn.
 2. Trot across the arena, stop.
 3. Perform a 270° ($3/4$) turn, and walk for approximately one horse length.
 4. Trot and continue across diagonal line and half arc right, stop at midline. Haunches at midline.
 5. Set up.
 6. Inspection.
 7. When dismissed, perform a 450° ($1\ 1/4$) turn.
 8. Extended trot down midline until past initial line.
 9. Walk approximately one horse length.
- Pattern is complete.

Note: The drawn description of this pattern is only intended for the general depiction of the pattern. Exhibitors should use the space as needed to best exhibit their horses.

WESTERN HORSEMANSHIP



1. Walk approximately two horse lengths and lope right lead.
 2. Counter canter square corner left, and small right lead circle.
 3. Change leads (simple or flying).
 4. Extended lope left lead large circle.
 5. Stop at center, perform a 540° (1 1/2) turn on the haunches to the left, back approximately 6 steps, and perform a 540° (1 1/2) turn on the haunches to the right.
 6. Extended jog, square corner and continue straight.
 7. Collect jog and jog until even with start cone.
- Pattern is complete.

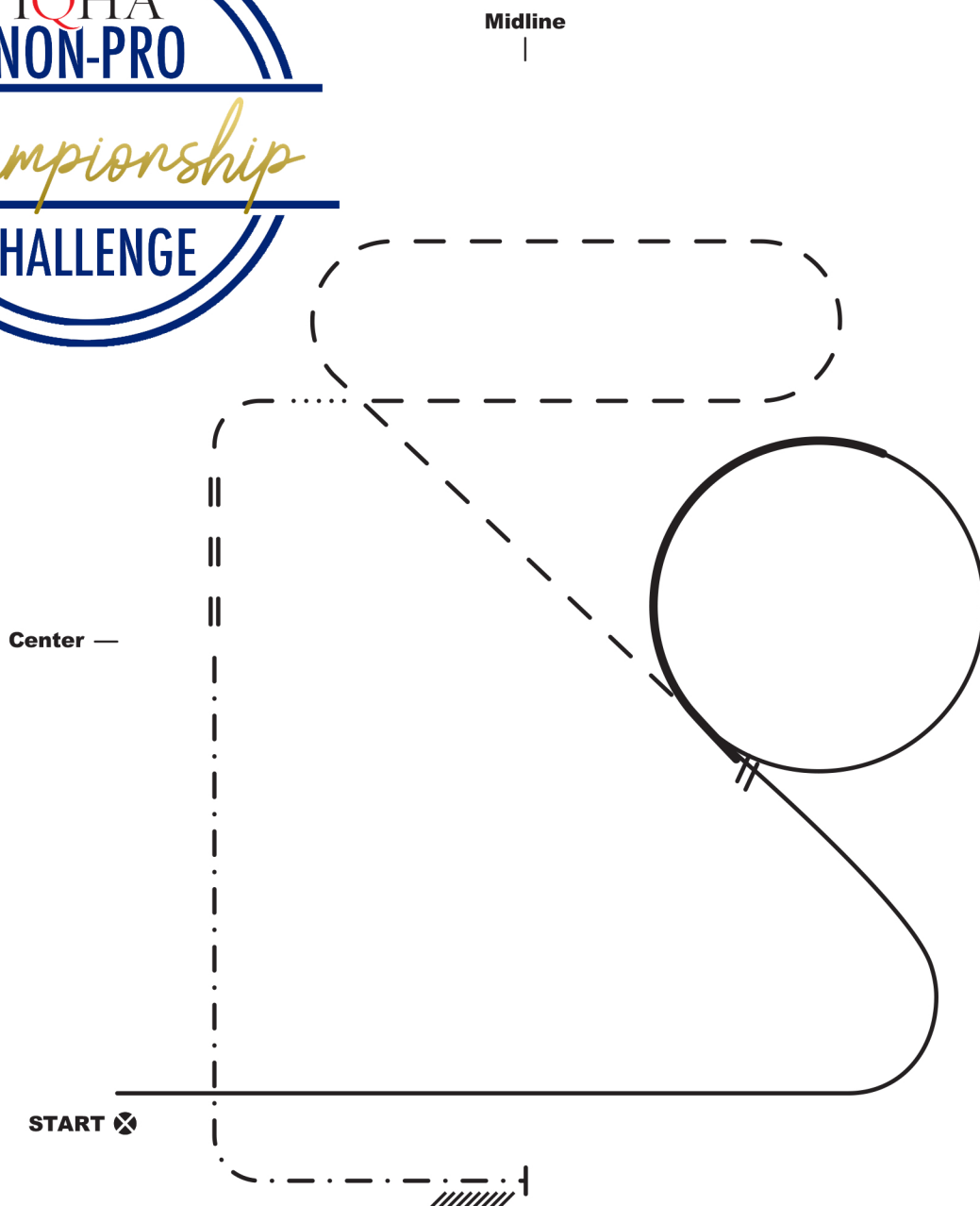

HUNT SEAT EQUITATION

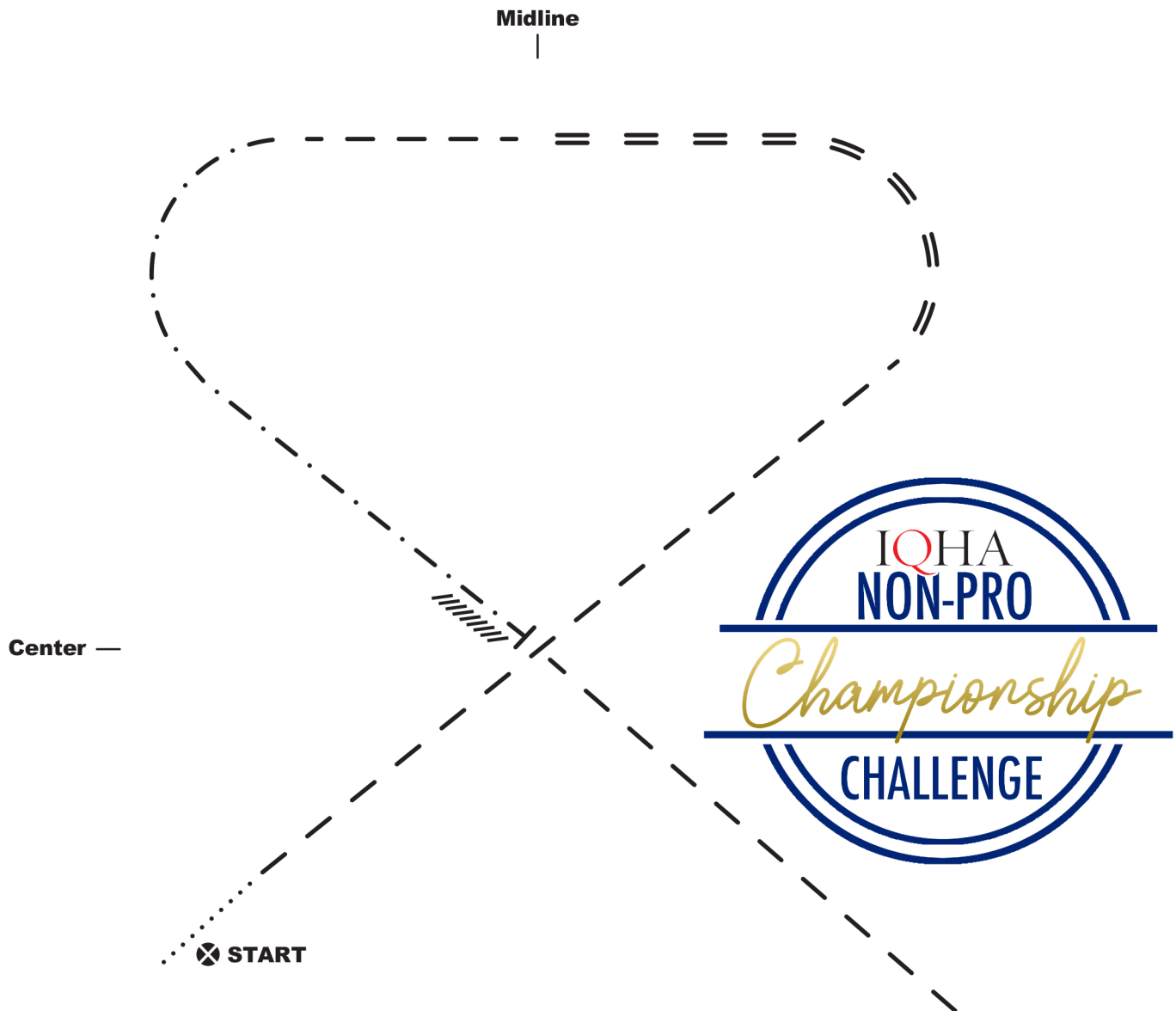


1. Left lead canter, arc left and continue across diagonal line.
 2. Before center, change leads (simple or flying).
 3. Canter right lead circle, hand gallop the first half of the circle (note: two-point), collect second half of the circle.
 4. Once circle is closed, trot left diagonal across diagonal line, arc right into a long oval.
 5. Once closed, walk for approximately five steps.
 6. Trot right diagonal and arc left.
 7. Two-point at the trot to center, then continue at the sitting trot until past the initial line, turn left.
 8. Halt, back approximately 6 steps.
- Pattern is complete.

WALK-TROT

HUNT SEAT EQUITATION



1. Walk approximately one horse length and trot left diagonal to center.
 2. At center, change diagonals and trot right diagonal.
 3. Before the corner, exhibit two-point position at the trot and continue until midline.
 4. At midline, trot right diagonal.
 5. Sitting trot around corner and across diagonal line to center.
 6. At center, stop and back approximately 6 steps.
 7. Trot left diagonal until even with start cone.
- Pattern is complete.
