

IQHYA Meeting Minutes February 13, 2026

Discussion included making some of the funds dedicated to youth members who do not go to Youth World to incentivize them to sell tickets. Brockelyn is looking at getting sponsorships as well. Marlie made a motion to pursue the raffle idea, seconded by Adelyn. Motion approved. Jennifer will look into the requirements for the raffle ticket sales.
